



# Inclusiveness

Hello Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to Unit 3 of our Kindness in the Classroom curriculum. For the next 4-6 weeks we will be learning all about INCLUSIVENESS. Since this is still a fairly new concept for children this age, we will focus on the following topics:

TOPIC	QUESTIONS WE WILL EXPLORE	HOW YOU CAN HELP AT HOME
<b>You are Special</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What makes each of us special?</li><li>• How can we celebrate our uniqueness?</li></ul>	Talk with your child about what makes them and your family special? How can you embrace the things that are “different” from everyone else?
<b>Teamwork</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Why do we need to work together?</li><li>• How can teamwork help us when we are trying to finish something?</li></ul>	Brainstorm ways to work with others in the classroom, on the playground, and even at home. What does teamwork look like?
<b>Inclusiveness</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How can we include others, even if we do not know them?</li><li>• Why is it important to give everyone a chance during games and other activities?</li></ul>	Discuss the connection between inclusiveness and kindness. Emphasize how including others requires kindness. We use our kind words and actions to make them feel welcome!

**Key activities we’ll be doing:**

- Celebrate our uniqueness!
- Highlight what makes us special!
- Discuss fairness and inclusiveness!
- Complete an egg based science experiment!
